DECLARATION OF A STATE OF CONSTITUTIONAL EXCEPTION OF CATASTROPHE, BY PUBLIC CALAMITY, IN THE TERRITORY OF CHILE, BY

THE LAPSE THAT INDICATES

No. 269.- Santiago, June 12, 2020. Seen:

The provisions of articles 19 No. 1 and 9, 32 No. 5, 39, 41 and 43 of the Political Constitution of the Republic; in Law No. 18,415, Constitutional Organic Law of States of Exception; in the decree with force of law Nº 1-19,653, of 2000, of the Ministry General Secretariat of the Presidency, which establishes the consolidated, coordinated and systematized text of the law No 18,575, Constitutional Organic of General Bases of the State Administration; in the decree with force of law No 725, of 1967, Sanitary Code; in Decree No. 4, of 2020, of the Ministry of Health, which decrees a health alert for the period indicated and grants extraordinary powers that indicate a public health emergency of international importance (ESPII) due to the outbreak of the new coronavirus (2019-NCOV), and its modifications; in Supreme Decree No. 156, of 2002, the Ministry of the Interior, which approves the National Civil Protection Plan, modified by Supreme Decrees No. 38, of 2011, and No. 697, of 2015, both of the Ministry of the Interior and Public Security; in Supreme Decree No. 104, of 2020, of the Ministry of the Interior and Public Security, which declares a constitutional state of emergency of catastrophe, due to public calamity, in the territory of Chile, and its modifications; in Supreme Decree No. 107, of 2020, of the Ministry of the Interior and Public Security, which declares the communes it indicates as areas affected by catastrophe; in the exempted resolutions, of 2020, of the Ministry of Health, which provide sanitary measures that indicate an outbreak of COVID-19, and in resolution No. 7, of and Nº 697, of 2015, both from the Ministry of the Interior and Public Security; in Supreme Decree No. 104, of 2020, of the Ministry of the Interior and Public Security, which declares a constitutional state of emergency of catastrophe, due to public calamity, in the territory of Chile, and its modifications; in Supreme Decree No. 107, of 2020, of the Ministry of the Interior and Public Security, which declares the communes it indicates as areas affected by catastrophe; in the exempted resolutions, of 2020, of the Ministry of Health, which provide sanitary measures that indicate an outbreak of COVID-19, and in resolution No. 7, of and No 697, of 2015, both from the Ministry of the Interior and Public Security; in Supreme Decree No. 104, of 2020, of the Ministry of the Interior and Public Security, which declares a constitutional state of emergency of catastrophe, due to public calamity, in the territory of Chile, and its modifications; in Supreme Decree No. 2019, of the Comptroller General of the Republic.

Considering:

- 1.- That, on the occasion of the COVID-19 outbreak that affects the country, classified as a pandemic by the World Health Organization, HE the President of the Republic declared through Supreme Decree No. 104, of March 18, 2020, of the Ministry of the Interior and Public Security, the constitutional state of exception of catastrophe, due to public calamity, throughout the national territory, for a term of 90 days.
- 2.- That, in the same way, by means of Supreme Decree No. 107, of the same year and origin, declared the 346 communes corresponding to the 16 regions of the country, as areas affected by the catastrophe, in the terms of the current provisions of Title I of Law No. 16,282, whose text was consolidated, coordinated and systematized by Supreme Decree No. 104, of 1977, of the Ministry of the Interior.
- 3.- That, in turn, the health authority, through different resolutions exempt from the The Ministry of Health has arranged a series of measures in various regions of the country, aimed at protecting the health of the population and preventing the spread of COVID-19, such as isolation measures, quarantines, health cords, health customs, among others.
- 4.- That, to date, the disease has caused the death of 2,870 people and the contagion of more than 160 thousand people in our country. Despite the efforts made to mitigate and control the spread of COVID-19, there are currently more than 26 thousand active cases, the circumstances that led to the declaration of a constitutional state of exception of catastrophe due to public calamity still exist.

- 5.- That, in this context, it has been deemed pertinent to extend the state of emergency constitutional catastrophe, due to public calamity, for the entire national territory, for an additional period of 90 days.
- 6.- That the Chilean Army has requested HE the President of the Republic, the replacement of the Chiefs of National Defense appointed in the Maule and Ñuble regions, based on considerations of the aforementioned institution.
 - 7.- That, taking into account the aforementioned,

Decree:

First article: The constitutional state of emergency of catastrophe, due to public calamity, declared in Chilean territory by Supreme Decree No. 104, of 2020, of the Ministry of the Interior and Public Security, and its modifications, be extended for an additional period of 90 days, starting from expiration of the period provided for in said administrative act.

Second article: From the date indicated in the preceding article, replace the Chiefs of National Defense of the Maule and Ñuble regions, Brigadier Generals (Army) Mr. Patrice Van de Maele Silva and Mr. Cristián Vial Maceratta, respectively, designated in the second article of supreme decree No. 104, of 2020, of this State Portfolio, by the following, as indicated:
