SUB: PREVENTION MEASURES FOR CORONA VIRUS [COVID-19].

It is to inform that number of seafarer sign-on during the last 30 [thirty] days must be mentioned in the Maritime Declaration of Health as per protocol of International Health Regulations-2005.

It is also inform that no vessel is allowed to berth at Karachi Seaport without completion of the period of 15 [days] from the date of sign-on the seafarer, otherwise PCR Test [Covid-19] must be carried out of the seafarer.

Permission for berthing shall be granted after submission of PCR Test [Covid-19] or completion of 15 days period of sign-on of the seafarer.

Furthermore, it is also suggested to circulate copy of this letter to all Shipping Agents for compliance.
