


Modality 1:Repatriation or change of combined crew



Requirements:

- 1.Confirmation of charter flight, airline, flight number, date and estimated times of arrival and departure.
- 2.For crew who would be embarking:
 - a.Medical Certificate showing that crew is in good health, issued by a Private or Public Clinic, sealed by a licensed Physician.
 - b.Self-health statement made by the crew and daily temperature readings (at least twice a day for 14 days) (Annex B, Circular No.4204/Add.14, dated May 5th, 2020).
 - c.Employer's letter and information sheet, regarding the change of crew.
- 3.For crew to be disembarked:
 - a.Maritime Health Statement, signed and sealed by the vessel of each crew member.
 - b.Certificate signed by the Captain on the health condition of all crew members.
 - c.Registration of temperature readings on board (at least twice a day).
- d.Responsibility letter from the Shipping Line, in which it certifies that the information provided for by the vessel is valid.
- e.List of the last 10 ports.
- f.Crew List, with date and place of embarkation.
- 4.Include all details regardin transportation of crew:
- d.Airport Hotel Port.
- e.Port Hotel Airport.
- Note: Stay in a hotel shall be in strict compliance, in the event of having to wait the flight or arrival of the vessel to port.
- 5. Confirmation of Hotel to be used.

Description:Consists of organizing the change of vessel crew about to arrive in jurisdictional waters of the Republic of Panama by shipping agencies which operate within the Country, such as Maersk, One, MSC, CMA CGM, Carnival, Royal Caribean, among others, as needed. These changes of crew would consist in organizing of charter flights both ways through airports, without the Republic of Panama, in non-risk pandemic areas, where after having complied with P1 Recommendation, and specifically under Letter A, number 1.1.10, on Document(s) which evidence condition of seafarers, same must be presented through a certificate issued by a licensed physician and submitted for approval of MINSA. It may consist of a charter flight in compliance with P2, P3, and P4 recommendations and which destination is Panama, for embarkation on a later date through an AuthorizedPort, based on P5 and in compliance with P6 recommendation upon boarding a vessel with destination to our waters.

This form of entry shall also be used for Panamanian Crew who have been sailing in vessels which navigational routes do not include the Republic of Panama, and their contracts have been terminated; thus, requiring them to return to their places of residence, in compliance with P1, P2, P3, and P4


In both cases, prior to embarking the flight to the Republic of Panama, when for risk analysis purposes Minsa requires that a Covid 19 Testing be made, the Shipping Lines must arrange same and send the results to the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Panama.

Note: Vessels must comply with basic Requirements for the arrival of vessels through the VUMPA platform and by e-mail (Procedure set forth).




Modality 2:Transfer of Crew from Ship to Ship

Requirements:

1.Certificate of Non COVID-19 by medical personnel, on board.

2.Records of temperatura readings.

3.Note which certifies the times which crew members have not had any contact with land personnel.

4.Date and Place of embarkation in present ship.

5.List of crew members to be disembarked, including their places of residence.

6.Responsability letter of crew member.



Modality4:Repatriation Ship to Ship under intermediate land




Requirements:

- 1.Reason for the operation
- 2.List of crew to be transferred.
- 3.Medical certificate of No Covid-29 on board.
- 4. Records of temperature readings for each crew member (at least twice a day).
- 5. Shipping companies shall make sure that their coronavirus (COVID-19) plans and procedures are fully complied with during embarking and disembarking of seafarers: Evidence that seafarers have adequate EPP.
 - ·Disinfection of luggage property of seafarers, in an area designated prior to embarking and disembarking.



Modality 5:Change of Crew, Panamanian for Panamanian, in National Ports



Requirements:

- 1.Request of Repatriation or Change of Crew by the Shipping Agency or Shipping Company, within a period of 72 to 96 hours prior thereto, to the e-mails as set forth.
- **2.For crew to be embarked:**
 - a.Medical Certificate showing that crew is in good health, issued by a Private or Public Clinic, sealed by a licensed Physician.
 - b.Self-health statement made by the crew and daily temperature readings (at least twice a day for 14 days) (Annex B, Circular No.4204/Add.14, dated May 5th, 2020).
 - c.Employer's letter and information sheet, regarding the change of crew.

3.For crew to be disembarked:



g.Information of Hotel certified or authorized by MINSA, where he or she will be staying, until appropriate flight charter is arranged.

h.Confirmation of arrangement of Repatriation Flight Charter, whether by Company or Shipping Agent, together with the Embassy of the country of citizenship of crew member and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
